FROM SAN JOSE (Hwy 87)

Highway 87 South, exit **Santa Teresa Blvd** (continue straight)

Turn right on **Coleman Road**

Turn left on **Winfield Blvd.**

Follow Winfield Rd. until end of road, there it turns into **Old Quarry Rd**

Continue approximately 0.8 miles to the Pro Shop

FROM SAN JOSE (Hwy 280 to 85 Route)

Take Highway 280 south, Highway 85 south, exit **Almaden Expressway**

Take Almaden Expy **south** to **Coleman Rd**

Turn left on to **Coleman Road**

Turn right on **Winfield Blvd.**

Follow Winfield Rd. until end of road, there it turns into **Old Quarry Rd**

Continue approximately 0.8 miles to the Pro Shop

***IMPORTANT NOTE :** This Golf Course is a Private Club and the PWWA asks that you please read and abide by the Club Dress/Etiquette rules listed below.

For all Members and Guests:

- Denim is allowed in the Clubhouse only
- All clothing should be properly pressed
- Cargo pants/shorts (pants/shorts with external pockets) are allowed only if they are of the stylish upscale type which is sold at first rate golf apparel shops and private golf club pro shops. Acceptable cargo pants/shorts are creased, made of finer fabrics, have very few external pockets, and the pockets that they do have are very flat on the surface of the pants. The type of cargo pants/shorts which are unacceptable are those which are heavy, bulky, sloppy, wrinkled, and have many balloon-like pockets. If in doubt, please do not wear the cargo pants/shorts.
- No sweat pants, sweatshirts, exercise clothing or warm-up suits
- Shorts and skirts cannot be more than 3 inches above the knee
- Golf shoes (soft spikes only) are allowed everywhere at the Club except in the "Dining Room"
- If a guest arrives dressed inappropriately, the member will be charged for whatever clothing is required to bring the guest's clothing into compliance with our dress code. Remember, it is the member's responsibility to notify his/her guests about all of the Club's rules (which are all on the Club's website)

For the Gentlemen:

- Men are required to have collared shirts with sleeves, turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks, or golf specific tees similar to those worn by professional golfers
- Shirts designed to be tucked in must be tucked in (shirts not long enough to be tucked in are not acceptable)
- Hats are allowed everywhere at the Club except in the "Dining Room". Hats may not be worn backwards

For the Ladies:

- All women's golfing attire that is sold in our Pro Shop and similar attire sold by other reputable golf retailers is acceptable
- No halter tops allowed
- No tank tops allowed
- No tennis shorts or tennis skirts allowed
- Ladies hats are allowed in all dining areas

Cell Phones:

- Cell phone use is prohibited everywhere inside the clubhouse except in the locker rooms
- Cell phones must be on vibrate mode at all times anywhere on the Club property
- Cell phone use is allowed on the decks and balconies of the building in non-dining areas only. Members and guests who are dining should not hear cell phones ringing or have cell phone conversations interfering with the enjoyment of their meals and drinks.
- Cell phone use is prohibited on the driving range and practice green. If cell phones need to be used in these areas, please walk to cart parking area or parking lots.
- Cell phone use is allowed:
 - On the golf course on cart paths only
 - In the men's and women's locker rooms
 - On decks and balconies only if outside of hearing range of guests dining or playing golf (No cell phones near first tee, please)
 - In parking lots and cart parking area next to driving range
